Our church is open for individual silent prayer between Saturday-Wednesday 08.30-18.00

New Lectionary: we will start using the new translation of the Bible during the liturgy from the beginning of Advent 2024. This requires obtaining new copies of the Lectionary. We are planning to buy three different types of Lectionaries (which we will use for various purposes) as well as a Book of the Gospels. The Lectionaries come in four volumes and each volume has a specified donor bookplate. If you would like to sponsor any of these, please email the parish office or provide your contact details on a piece of paper to one of the priests outlining which edition you would like to sponsor. The ambo edition costs £700 (so £175 per donor), the chapel edition costs £400 (so £100 per donor), the study edition costs £250 (so £63 per donor) and the Book of the Gospels costs £400 (so £400 per donor). We are unfortunately limited to the number of donors that we can inscribe on these books, therefore, this will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
